



Education curriculum for EOS – Thin Client

The training curriculum for EOS Thin Client is comprised of the following course:

Training Module 1
EOS Thin Client Usage and Administration
(1 day)

The training method employed in this course combines both theory and practice, allowing for an optimal assimilation of the training material.

This course is designed for a dedicated education environment. The duration of this course provides enough time to outline and explore the usage of EOS Thin Client, as well as providing adequate time for discussing recommendations that relate to the specific target environment.



Training Module 1 EOS Thin Client Usage and Administration

(1 day)

Introduction

This course covers the main functions relevant to the usage and administration of EOS Thin Client.

Objectives

At the end of this course, the student will be able to:

- manage his or her reports: display, search, print, restore and customize his or her reports,
- perform searches within the documents, employing specific criteria,
- convert his or her documents into Excel files, while retaining the conversion models and
- understand and implement administrative customization.

Target audience

EOS Thin Client users, administrators and support personnel.

Prerequisite knowledge or experience

PC experience.

Course Outline

- Report management
Displaying and searching within a document, table of contents usage, restoring and printing of documents. Classroom exercises.
- Report customization
Line and column maintenance, column selection, and modification of display rules. Classroom exercises.
- Searching report indexes.
Filter definition and usage. Classroom exercises.
- Exporting and converting reports.
Exporting. Simple and complex conversions. Saving and exporting conversion models. Classroom exercises.
- Architecture.
- Customization with classroom exercises.

Training method and course material

- Classroom training (1 day) with the first half of the course dedicated to the usage of the product and the second half of the course dedicated to product administration which must be performed by future administrators of the product's software.
- Classroom lectures interspersed with training exercises in a dedicated education environment.
- Each student receives a training manual.
